Dr Koh Kar Chai is the Immediate Past President of the Malaysian Medical Association, the current President of the Manipal Alumni Association Malaysia, Vice Chair of the Confederation of Medical Associations in Asia and Oceania, and the Treasurer of the Commonwealth Medical Association.

Having graduated from Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore University in 1991, he is now practising as a General Practitioner in Kuala Lumpur.

Prof Dr Sazzli Kasim

Prof Sazzli Kasim is the National Specialist Register (NSR) Certified trainer in Cardiology. He leads the construction of Universiti Teknologi MARA's teaching hospital in Puncak Alam, Selangor.

With a passion to raise the standards of cardiology care and services in Malaysia, Prof Kasim has been actively involved in the education and training of the medical community in this field. He has delivered many lectures and seminars for both the public and healthcare professionals in raising awareness in cardiovascular conditions and other disease areas. He was the Organizing Chair for the Annual Scientific Meeting for the National Heart Association in 2017, and an active member of the European Society of Cardiology, Irish Cardiac Society, and European Atherosclerotic Society. He is an avid researcher as well as involved in several guidelines writing committees pertinent to his field.

Prof Sazzli graduated from the National University of Ireland, Cork with MB BCh in 2001 and subsequently completed his training in Internal Medicine and Cardiology in 2011 and was awarded the Certificate of Satisfactory Completion of Specialist Training (CSCST) from Irish College of Higher Medical Training. He is currently a council member with the National Heart Association Malaysia and the College of Physician Malaysia as well as a fellow with the European Society of Cardiology. Prof Kasim is also a member of the editorial board for the Journal of Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology, published by Radcliffe Cardiology on behalf of the Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology.



Prof Dr Raja Affendi Raja Ali

Prof Dr Raja Affendi Raja Ali has extensive experience in the field of clinical, academic and research in gastroenterology and hepatology. He was a Dean for the faculty of Medicine, UKM from 2019-2022 and currently serves as a Dean of the School of Medical and Life Sciences at Sunway University. He is also a Professor of Medicine and a consultant physician in gastroenterology and hepatology at the UKM Specialist Centre. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh and the American Gastroenterological Association. He has been awarded multiple research grants to study patients with colorectal cancer, inflammatory bowel disease, and gut microbiome. He has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals, with over 115 publications to his name. He is an active clinical trialist and contributes significantly to the development of new treatments and therapies in the field of gastroenterology and hepatology. In addition to his professional achievements, he has served in several leadership roles and successfully completed an Oxford Executive Leadership Program as well as international Deans course sponsored by The German Academic Exchange program. He is an immediate Past President of the Malaysia Society of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Treasurer for the Asia Pacific Association of Gastroenterology, and a member of the educational committee for the Asian Organization for Crohn's and Colitis and Clinical Research Committee for the World Gastroenterology Organization. In 2018-2019, he was selected by the World Endoscopy Organization to attend their Emerging Stars Program. He also graduated with honours degree in Master of Business Administration from the International University Malaya-Wales.



Dr Sanjiv Rampal

Dr Sanjiv Rampal, an Orthopaedic Surgeon in Beacon Hospital is also a senior lecturer in Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences in University Putra Malaysia.

Dr Sanjiv had been extensively trained in both local and international institutions in the field of joint replacement and reconstruction.

Dr Sanjiv is an expert on total hip replacement and knee arthroplasty surgery. His various apprenticeship training abroad -Germany, France, Italy and Singapore also exposed him to other wider spectrum of expertise including hip and knee region and other pathological causes.



Dr Ch'ng Chin Chwen

Dr Ch'ng Chin Chwen is a consultant dermatologist registered with National Specialist Registry (NSR), currently working in Subang Jaya Medical Centre.

She graduated as a gold medalist from University Malaya in 2006, obtained Membership of Royal Colleges of Physician of UK in 2010, joined dermatology team on the same year in University Malaya to continue her training in dermatology subspecialty. She completed Advanced Master in Dermatology in 2014, on the same year she was appointed as the Head of Division of Dermatology in University Malaya. She also did a visiting fellowship in cutaneous laser surgery in Mahidol University in 2017.

Dr Ch'ng is involved in the development of Malaysian Clinical Practice Guidelines for Management of Atopic Eczema which was launched in early 2019. She was appointed as advisor of several advisory boards. She has published articles in numerous international journals and is an expert reviewer for several reputable international dermatology journals. She has been invited to speak at numerous forums, workshops, radios and TV programs as well.
